Andreea has been selected, at the age of 23 - as the youngest Executive Director of FILIA. As a young leader of a 20-year old, well-established organization, her team's focus has been to improve women's access to information about reproductive health and safety, through activism, advocacy, studies/analyzes and grassroots work. Since 2019, FILIA's staff has grown from 6 to 15 employees, while the organization's budget increased by almost 100%.

Under her leadership, the FILIA Center has consolidated its voice as a watchdog that advocates for the women's dignity and safety and against any form of women discrimination or denigration.

"Being my first experience in the United States, I was nervous both for the time zone difference and the lack of contact with the family and the workplace, as well as for living with a family that I did not know beforehand. But the Open World experience has completely exceeded my expectations in terms of inter-cultural exchange, openness and kindness. The warmth we received from our American family and the host organization was amazing. Regarding the professional side of the program, I observed that the cultural differences in terms of civic involvement and especially fundraising make it complicated to replicate, but tools can be adapted to the local specifics of Romania."

"What impressed me the most in this trip is the tradition of volunteerism and social involvement. The extra years of American democracy compared to the young Romanian democracy translate especially into this type of involvement in the community, which you meet at every step.
